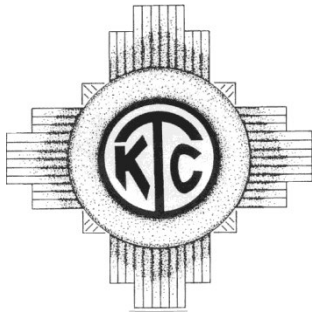

RAMP - At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp through all levels of competition: Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever, American Water Spaniel, Boykin Spaniels, English Springer Spaniel, Field Spaniel, Welsh Springer Spaniel, Grand Basset Griffon Vendeen, Whippet, German Pinscher, Standard Schnauzer, American Staffordshire Terrier, Irish Terrier, Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Finnish Spitz, Australian Cattle Dogs, Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Finnish Lapphund, Icelandic Sheepdog, Mudi, Norwegian Buhund, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Puli, Spanish Water Dog, Norrbottenspet.

The following breeds may be judged on the ground, table or ramp: Miniature Bull Terrier.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Lagotto Romagnolo, Clumber Spaniel, Sussex Spaniel, Basset Hound, Cirneco dell'Etna, Kerry Blue Terrier, Bulldog, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chow, Keeshond.

Junior showmanship judges should follow the above.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.) 4/3/24

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Field Trial Dogs and Bitches - Must have a Dual Championship, Field Championship, Amateur Field Championship, or have placed in an AKC Field Trial in the past year.

Veteran Dogs and Bitches – 7 years of age and older.

Neutered Veteran Dogs or Spayed Veteran Bitches may be entered at independent specialty shows.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

Best of Breed (Variety) Competition - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, dogs that, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES, INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class - For bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The award will be based on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Rally will start with Master Class and going on down. Jump order will be tall to small. Rally ring will be approximately 40' x 50'.
In case of a tie for High Combined, the combined times of the runs RA and RE will be used as the tie breaker.
In case of a tie for High Combined Triple, the combined times of the runs RA, RE and RM will be used as the tie breaker.

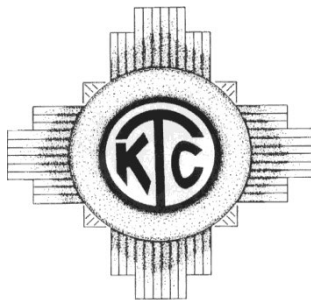

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

SHOW RULES

By entering or attending our shows, you are agreeing to abide by the following rules. Failure to follow them may lead to a hearing. Remember, all complaints regarding conduct prejudicial to the sport will be dealt with by the show committee in accordance with AKC rules, which could result in disciplinary action.

General

Exhibitors must observe the rules on all signage posted by the Coyote Classic Dog Shows, and the Pima County Fairgrounds/Southwestern Fair Commission.

Fire Lanes must be kept open at all times. Fire Lanes may not be used to load, unload, crate, or groom dogs.

Loading and unloading is only allowed in zones designated for that purpose. Old Pueblo Hall and Thurber Hall have clearly marked designated loading and unloading areas. You must leave your lights or flashers on during this process. Be considerate of your fellow exhibitors by removing your vehicle from the area as quickly as possible.

This is a SELF-CLEANING EVENT. Cleanup equipment is provided. All exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for cleaning up after their dogs; this includes all aisles, all surrounding areas, parking lots of the show site, and hotel/motel sites.

If your dog soils in the ring, the ring steward will hold your dog while you do the cleanup.

Put all waste in the proper receptacles.

Do not allow your dog to relieve itself on the buildings, shrubbery, or trash receptacles.

Use of flexible or retractable leads is FORBIDDEN on show grounds during show hours.

Arizona leash laws are enforced. Having a dog at large is a misdemeanor under Arizona law. Your dog must be kept in an enclosed area when on your property. Tie outs are prohibited. Even if a dog causes no harm, the law says it should be restrained by a leash when in public.

No crates or pens will be allowed within 20 feet of any ring, with the exception of **Temporary Crating**.

Temporary Crating. Temporary Crating at ringside will be allowed in designated areas for purposes of showing only at the show giving clubs. Dogs in these areas must be in crates, cannot be left unattended (except for agent being in the ring), may arrive no more than 10 minutes before judging for their breed, and must be removed immediately after judging of their breed. Crating must be situated so that there is a clear path for exhibitors to approach the rings. No more than one large crate or dolly per exhibitor. No more than 3 crates or dollies side-by-side without a path. Paths must be maintained between crates and dollies for safety reasons.

Dogs must not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures.

Exhibitors are advised to bring ground cover, though no mats can be placed under exercise pens on grassy areas to avoid damage to the grass.

Dogs are not allowed to be left outside all night in exercise pens or crates anywhere on show grounds after 10:00 p.m.

Old Pueblo Hall and Thurber Hall

THURBER HALL WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE OR OPENED TO EXHIBITORS UNTIL 5:00 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY.

OLD PUEBLO HALL WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE OR OPENED TO EXHIBITORS UNTIL 6:00 A.M. ON THURSDAY.

ONLY PAINTER'S TAPE is allowed on the floors in Old Pueblo Hall and Thurber Hall (per the Pima County Fairgrounds and the Southwestern Fair Commission, Inc.)

Grooming in Old Pueblo Hall and Thurber Hall is only permitted in the designated Unreserved and Reserved Grooming areas.

The Classic Committee and the show committee reserve the right to require the stacking of crates and any other remedies it may deem necessary for space on a case-by-case basis at their discretion. We encourage exhibitors to use their space efficiently to allow everyone the opportunity to have space.

Dogs may NOT remain in Old Pueblo Hall or Thurber Hall overnight!

No exercise pens may be set-up inside the buildings at any time.

The buildings will be locked between 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. There is no overnight security in the buildings.

Dogs and exhibitors must leave the buildings within one hour following BIS judging on Monday.

Grooming & Bathing

No grooming will be allowed ringside.

There will be limited Unreserved Grooming areas in Old Pueblo Hall and Thurber Hall. There is ample space on the Polo Field for exhibitors to set up their own portable tenting, with easy access to both buildings. On the north and east sides of Thurber Hall, there are grassy areas with trees for setups, with some access to power along the north wall.

In the designated Unreserved and Reserved Grooming areas, access to electrical plugs is NOT exclusive and is not reserved.

Bathing of dogs with hoses will only be allowed in the tubs provided by the Classic, located outdoors, southeast of Old Pueblo Hall and northeast of Thurber Hall. No dog bathing will be permitted in any other area of the Fairgrounds. Each Exhibitor is responsible for clean-up in and around their set-up.

Vehicle Rules

All vehicles must stay on the roads or within designated parking and unloading areas.

Vehicle traffic in the area between Old Pueblo Hall, Thurber Hall, and the Polo Field will be kept to a minimum during event hours for the safety of our exhibitors and their dogs.

With the exception of Box Vans parking in a designated Box Van parking area, absolutely no vehicles will be allowed on the polo field.

Fire lanes must be kept open at all times.

Automobile flashers or headlights must remain on during unloading.

Good sportsman-like conduct extends to the unloading zones too! Abuse of parking privileges can result in a bench hearing.

Any vehicle parked in front of any reserved motor home parking space must be owned by the person who paid for the reserved parking space.

Any vehicle parked, even short term, in an RV or box van space, must have paid for that space.

Do not remove cones or barriers- they indicate places that you should not drive past/park beyond.

Day of Show Parking

Day of show parking is free and will be available in areas designated by the Coyote Classic.

Parking is allowed in marked officials or handicapped parking area ONLY with a displayed officials parking pass or appropriate handicapped license or permit.

Regarding Dogs Locked in Vehicles

Action can and will be taken to rescue any dog in distress that is confined to a vehicle. All vehicle owners on the show premises automatically waive their rights to legal action or damages regarding dogs in distress that are confined to a vehicle.

All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the Coyote Classic, Tucson Kennel Club and/or Greater Sierra Vista Kennel Club or their members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog in distress.

The Coyote Classic regards the health, safety and life of any dog on the show grounds to be paramount to other property or privacy rights. We will not page anyone to a vehicle; we will take action.

RV and Box Van Parking

All RV and Box Van parking reservations during the period Monday November 11th through Monday November 18th, 2023 must be made through the Coyote Classic by using coyoteclassic.org or by contacting parking2024@coyoteclassic.org for a paper form. Additional rules for parking will be provided during the reservation process, and must be okayed.

Parking hours are posted in the Judging Program and online at: <http://coyoteclassic.org/Exhibitors/Parking>. For the safety of other exhibitors and RV guests, if you arrive outside of these hours, you will be directed to a temporary lot until parking opens.

Vehicle traffic in the area between Old Pueblo Hall, Thurber Hall, and the Polo Field will be kept to a minimum during event hours for the safety of our exhibitors and their dogs. **Should you reserve an RV space within this area and arrive during event hours, we reserve the right to temporarily park you elsewhere until the event is complete.**

Only one Box Van/vehicle allowed per Box Van Space. Visitors/client must park elsewhere.

Only one tow vehicle allowed per RV space. Vehicle tags will be required for tow vehicles to access RV areas.

Overnight RV Handicapped Parking

Anyone requesting handicapped parking must have a valid Handicap permit or plate. The Pima County Fairgrounds facility is handicap accessible. Please choose the parking zone that best suits your individual needs. Handicapped Parking does not mean "Near the Rings"; it means an accessible surface and space.

This club and/or its superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendents assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
2. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and declined credit card. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check or declined credit card MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the superintendent. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held at the Superintendent's Office. PLEASE BRING YOUR IDENTIFICATION TICKETS TO THE SHOW.
4. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours are 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
5. All trophies and prizes must be claimed at the Trophy Table. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available online at www.akc.org.
7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitor's setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
9. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
10. There is no provision offered for un-entered dogs at this show.
11. Declination of Entries. The Tucson Kennel Club and the Greater Sierra Vista Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
14. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
15. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
16. All rights to TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the CLUB, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Showgrounds, at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show, or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, video tape, audiotape, or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
17. The Kennel Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.
18. The Pima County Fairgrounds holds a #6 Liquor License.
19. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be transferred to another class, provided the dog and handler are both eligible and the class and judge are available and, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the superintendent at least 30 minute prior to the start of each trial.
16. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
17. Bitches in season are ineligible to compete in trials. To receive a refund, a veterinarian's letter needs to be received by the Superintendent no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for bitch in season cancellations.
18. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their children.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors Meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitutions must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes which have been approved to date by AKC.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC Event Records Department (919) 233-9767.

Tucson Kennel Club and Greater Sierra Vista Kennel Club offer a Rosette for Each Group Placement.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS. .AKC Revised 5/11/18*

Regulations Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- Closing date and time for this competition may be listed as any date and time prior to the event including the same day as the event and must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized
- breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

Exhibition Only in the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy (BPUP) Competition The regulations for the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy (BPUP) competition have been modified to allow professional handlers to exhibit dogs they own for exhibition only. Dogs must be marked as exhibition only on their entry form and are subject to the entry fees and eligibility requirements of the class. The exhibition only status of an entry may not be changed after the closing of entries. Exhibition only entries will be judged (examined and gaited) as all other entries but will not be considered for awards. Exhibition only entries will not be included in the calculation of Certificate of Merit (CM) and Puppy of Achievement (POA) points. Exhibition only entries in BPUP is available for events occurring on or after July 31, 2024.

Best of Breed – Orange; Best of Opposite Sex – Lavender;

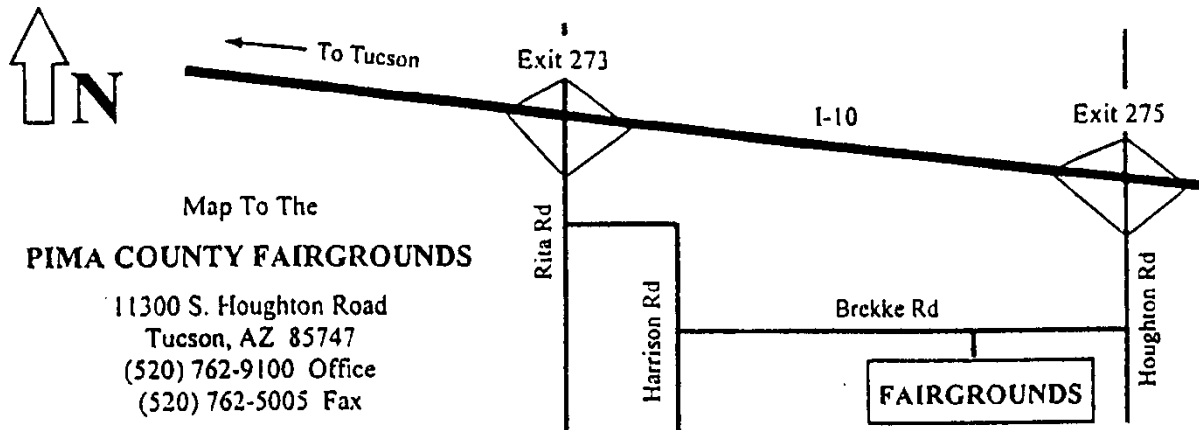

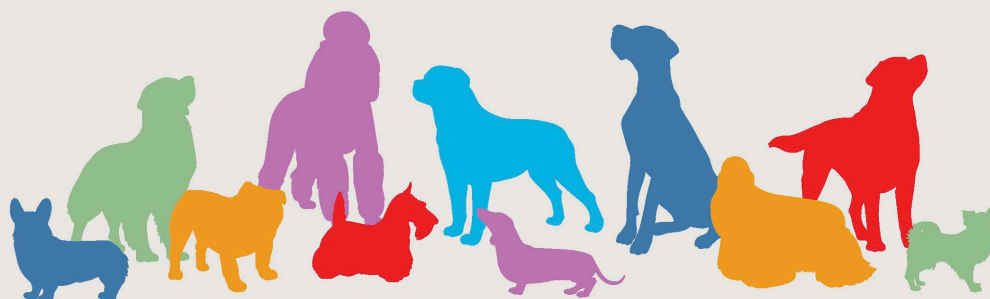
